

1. Q: During POST the display shows "Mac address are invalid in both CMOS and DMI. Press F1 to resume". What should I do?

2. Q: My CPU is Duron FSB 200 MHz CPU. Why my DDR 400 SDRAM can only run at DDR 266 speed on the K7VT6 motherboard?

A: According to the specification of VIA KT600, only DDR 266 SDRAM is supported if FSB 200 MHz CPU is installed. DDR 400 SDRAM is supported with FSB 266, 333, or 400 MHz CPU. Please refer to the following supporting table.

FSB \ Memory	DDR 266	DDR 333	DDR 400
200 MHz	Yes	No	No
266 MHz	Yes	Yes	Yes
333 MHz	Yes	Yes	Yes
400 MHz	Yes	Yes	Yes

3. Q: I used Prescott CPU and P4I45GV/P4I65GV. I wanted to use NT4.0, but the installation can not be completed. What should I do?

A: For Prescott CPU, some OSes (ex.NT4.0) can not be installed. In order to boot legacy OSes that cannot support CPUs with extended CPUID functions, please flash to the latest BIOS to enable "Max CPUID Value Limit" (Advanced => CPU Configuration)
